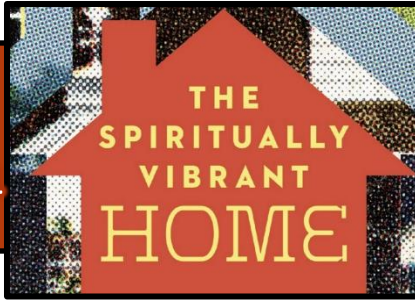

**We enter to worship; we exit to witness!**

<sup>1</sup>These are the commands, decrees, and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess, <sup>2</sup>so that you, your children, and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all His decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life. <sup>3</sup>Hear, O Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your fathers, promised you.

<sup>4</sup>Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup>Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup>These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. <sup>7</sup>Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup>Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. <sup>9</sup>Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

<sup>10</sup>When the LORD your God brings you into the land He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you—...<sup>12</sup>be careful that you do not forget the LORD, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

HOLY GOSPEL

<sup>29</sup>The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! <sup>30</sup>This is the one I meant when I said, ‘A man who comes after me has surpassed me because He was before me. <sup>31</sup>I myself did not know Him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that He might be revealed to Israel”

<sup>32</sup>Then John gave this testimony: “I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on Him. <sup>33</sup>I would not have known Him, except that the One who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is He who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.’ <sup>34</sup>I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God.”

<sup>35</sup>The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. <sup>36</sup>When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, “Look, the Lamb of God!”

<sup>37</sup>When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. <sup>38</sup>Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, “What do you want?”

They said, “Rabbi” (which means Teacher), “Where are you staying?”

<sup>39</sup>“Come,” He replied, “and you will see.

So they went and saw where He was staying, and spent that day with Him. It was about the tenth hour.

<sup>40</sup>Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. <sup>41</sup>The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, “We have found the Messiah” (that is, the Christ). <sup>42</sup>And he brought him to Jesus.
