<sup>13</sup>Since we have the same spirit of faith according to what has been written, “I believe, and so I spoke,” we also believe, and so we also speak, <sup>14</sup>knowing that He who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us with you into His presence. <sup>15</sup>For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.

<sup>16</sup>So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup>For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, <sup>18</sup>as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

<sup>1</sup>For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. <sup>2</sup>For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling, <sup>3</sup>if indeed by putting it on we may not be found naked. <sup>4</sup>For while we are still in this tent, we groan, being burdened—not that we would be unclothed, but that we would be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. <sup>5</sup>He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.

<sup>6</sup>So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, <sup>7</sup>for we walk by faith, not by sight. <sup>8</sup>Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. <sup>9</sup>So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please Him. <sup>10</sup>For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

HOLY GOSPEL

John 17:1-2, 8-11, 14-21

<sup>1</sup>When Jesus had spoken these words, He lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, “Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son that the Son may glorify You, <sup>2</sup>since You have given Him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given Him. ...

<sup>8</sup>For I have given them the words that You gave Me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from You; and they have believed that You sent Me. <sup>9</sup>I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. <sup>10</sup>All mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. <sup>11</sup>And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, which You have given Me, that they may be one, even as We are one. ... <sup>14</sup>I have given them Your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. <sup>15</sup>I do not ask that You take them out of the world, but that You keep them from the evil one. <sup>16</sup>They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. <sup>17</sup>Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth. <sup>18</sup>As You sent Me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. <sup>19</sup>And for their sake I consecrate Myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.
